- 2. Products must be in accord with The Teachings of "How To Eat To Live" Books 1 & 2 by The Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad.
- 3. Food and non-food items must show product ingredients/contents and be safe for all users.
- 4. Producer of products must state where products are produced and by whom they are produced.
